Complaining the wilful disobedience of the direction issued in CWP-20260-2021 on 05.10.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

The operative part of the order reads as under:-

“Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent no. 2 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 10.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) within a period of 6 weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case of positive decision, the rent will become payable from the time the petitioner claims to have been living separately. In case there is any legal impediment and the relief is to be denied, speaking order be passed and communicated to the petitioner forthwith.”

Learned State counsel has submitted that the order has been complied with and the petitioner has been held entitled to House Rent Allowance since 30.05.2021.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the petitioner is entitled to House Rent Allowance from 30.05.2020.

In view of the aforesaid, no further order is required to be

passed. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file representation in this regard which shall be considered by the competent authority i.e the Director, School Education, Haryana, in accordance with law.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
