Petitioner-Jyoty has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking issuance of directions for transfer of investigation in case FIR No.10 dated 26.01.2021 under Sections 323, 325, 148 and 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station D Division, Amritsar filed against private respondents to some independent agency.

Pursuant to the order dated 29.10.2021, learned State counsel on instructions from SI Purshottam Lal has stated that in all there were five accused in the subject FIR and after completion of investigation, two accused, namely, Rakesh Arora and Madhav Arora were declared innocent and the final report has been prepared against remaining three accused persons, namely, Mayank Arora, Paras Arora and Dhruv Arora. He further states that the final report would be

submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction within next two weeks.

In view of the above stand of learned State counsel, no further orders are called for in this petition.
