Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.18 dated 15.2.2021 under Sections 406, 498-A, registered at Women Police Station Chandigarh.

By virtue of the order dated 4.10.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court but the mediation could not succeed.

Report of the Mediator has also been received affirming the above said fact.

I have interacted with respondent No.2-complainant and her husband, who are present in person and found that there are no chances of settlement at this stage. The matter needs to be decided on merits.

Respondent No.2 has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 4.10.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
