Prayer in the present petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.225, dated 15.7.2020 registered under Section 458, 354, 436, 427, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Philluar, District Jalandhar.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that now the matter already stands compromised and a petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise has already been filed by way of CRM-M-35898-2021, which is pending adjudication.

Ms. Sakshi Bakshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice and on instructions from ASI Gurdev Lal submits that PO proceedings have already been initiated against the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners candidly submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to surrender before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In case, the petitioners surrender and file appropriate application before the Court concerned within 10 days from today, the Court concerned is requested to decide his application for grant of bail expeditiously preferably within 2 days from the date of filing of the same.

If the petitioners surrender and file appropriate application as aforesaid within 10 days their arrest would remain stayed till the decision of the said application.
