RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
in view of the letter dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure P-27), issued by the Indian
Nursing Council, whereby the last date of admission for the Academic Year
2021-2022, has been extended up to 07.04.2022, nothing further survives in
the petition except for issuing a direction to the respondent-State authorities

to extend the date and complete the admission process by 07.04.2022. He further submits that though, the representations were filed before the State authorities on 02.04.2022 and 03.04.2022, but the same have not yielded any results.

Dr. Shaleen, Director, Medical Education and Research, Haryana, who is present in Court, submits that the file is under process. He further submits that, in any case, the authorities would ensure that the counseling is extended up to 07.04.2022. In view of the aforesaid, taking the letter dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure P-27) into consideration and the statement of the Director, Medical Education and Research, Haryana (ibid), the petition is accordingly disposed of. The other issues raised in the petition are left open for being considered and decided in appropriate case.

At this stage, in view of the several difficulties being faced in streamlining the admission process, learned counsel appearing for the Indian Nursing Council as well as the Director, Medical Education and Research, Haryana, submit that they shall work in tandem to resolve the aforesaid issue, while keeping the provisions of the Central legislation and the State legislation in mind. It is submitted that they shall do so, at the earliest, to avert any such difficulty for the next academic session.
