The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for calling the status report in complaint dated 31.08.2020 and complaint dated 02.12.2020 disclosing the commission of cognizable offences by the accused persons despite the protection order dated 16.02.2021 passed by this Court.

As per status report dated 30.09.2021 filed by the State, during inquiry into the application dated 02.12.2020 filed by the petitioner, no facts or evidence were found which proves that Sukhdev Singh, retired SP, had sent Constable Buta Singh to the house of the petitioner. The petitioner has filed application dated 02.12.2020 on the basis of false and baseless allegations against Head Constables Buta Singh and Sukhdev Singh Virk. The life and property of the petitioner is not in danger.

In view of the above report, learned counsel for the

petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to seek protection of his life and liberty in future, in case of apprehension of any danger by him from respondents No.5 to 8.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
