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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Petitioner had sought release on parole on account of fact that his father was ill. He had remained admitted in ICU as his condition was critical.

Vide order dated 2.3.2022, petitioner was directed to be released on parole for a period of 4 weeks. The period of 4 weeks is due to expire on 5.4.2022.

Mr. Jindal, learned counsel for petitioner states that father of petitioner expired on 25.3.2022. A panchayatnama regarding death of his father has been annexed as Annexure P-3.

It is stated that petitioner is only son and he would be required to perform various rites and rituals in connection with death of his father. Accordingly, he prays that parole granted to him may be extended for a period of 2 more weeks.

Notice of motion.

Mr. B.S. Sewak, Additional A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent State.

In view of aforesaid, parole granted vide order dated 2.3.2022 is extended by a period of 2 more weeks. Petitioner would now surrender before jail authorities on or before 19.4.2022.
