This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure directing the respondents No. 2 and 3 to conduct faire and impartial investigation in FIR No. 80 dated 16.05.2016 under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal code, registered at Police Station Phase-I, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali with further prayer to complete the investigation in accordance with law and present the challan.

Notice of motion was issued in the present case and in pursuance of the same, learned State counsel has filed reply on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3.

The learned State counsel has pointed out that as per the said reply, respondent No. 4 was arrested on 21.11.2018 and thereafter he was granted bail vide order dated 05.12.2018 and the challan has been presented in the Court on 26.11.2020 and submitted that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the averments.

Keeping in view the fact that respondent No. 4 has been arrested and the challan has been presented in the Court, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
