This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the PO order dated 07.05.2013 (Annexure P-3) passed in FIR No.234 dated 06.10.2011, registered under Sections 307, 120-B and 458 IPC and Section 27 Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar, as the same has been passed in violation of Section 82(1) Cr.P.C. as 30 days time has not been given to the petitioner.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that previously also, the petitions were filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of abovesaid order dated 07.05.2013 (Annexure P-3), however, the same were not pressed and were withdrawn on 08.05.2018 and 15.10.2019, whereas petition bearing CRM-M-11807-2022 was dismissed on merits on 22.03.2022. He submits that now the petitioner has arrived in India and is willing to participate in the trial proceedings, therefore, the impugned order be set aside.

After hearing the learned counsel and considering the above

background, this Court is not inclined to entertain this fourth petition on the same cause of action, therefore, the same is dismissed.
