Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No. 12 dated 28.01.2020, registered under Sections 379, 447, 506, 109 of the IPC at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

At the very outset, learned State counsel has raised an objection that petitioner Nos. 1 and 8 have already been arrested and eight anticipatory bail applications, filed by other co-accused, are pending before the Court of Sessions, therefore, this petition is premature as even the investigation is going on.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer and submits the petitioners may be given liberty to file a detailed representation before the SSP, Sangrur along with all the supporting documents in their defence and the same may be decided before presentation of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

In view of the same, the present petition is dismissed being

premature.

In case the petitioners move a detailed representation before the SSP, Sangrur along with all the supporting documents within a period of one week from today, the same will be marked to the Investigating Officer and the Investigating Officer will decide the same before presenting the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.
