Prayer is for grant for regular bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.363 dated 06.09.2021 registered under Section 379-B of IPC, 1860, Police Station Urban Estate Rohtak, District Rohtak, Haryana.

The counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 06.09.2021 and even the complainant has been examined during the trial and it will take time for termination of the trial. The counsel further made prayer for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

The present petition is contested by the State Counsel who submitted that the petitioner snatched scooty from complainant-Seema and is now facing trial with regard to the same.

The FIR in this case was registered against the unknown person who snatched the scooty from the complainant. The petitioner was arrested in this case on 06.09.2021. On completion of investigation challan was presented and charges were also framed and during trial complainant has already been examined, however, it will take time for conclusion of the trial. Petitioner is also involved in another criminal case, out of which, he is in custody in three cases and is on bail in one case. He is not absconding in any of the criminal cases which have been registered against him. So this court is of the view that the aforesaid criminal history of the petitioner is no ground to decline his prayer for grant of regular bail in the present case and no purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody for any further period.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is hereby ordered to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned during the pendency of the trial.
