[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 10.02.2022 in CRM-M No.52608 of 2021 in case titled as Jagjit Singh vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on 02.04.2022 while accepting notice, learned State Counsel had informed that respondent No.1 had recommended to the ADGP Security to provide security to the petitioner.

[3] Today, learned Addl. A.G. informs that vide order dated 04.04.2022, one gunman with weapon has been deputed for the security of the petitioner.
