This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondent No.3 i.e. The Board of Directors/Revisional Authority to hear and decide the statutory revision dated 16.9.2019 (Annexure P-6) along with prayer for stay and additional submissions dated 12.2.2022 (Annexure P-7). It is further prayed that during the pendency of the present petition, the operation of the impugned order dated 11.12.2018 (Annexure P-4), passed by respondent No.1 and order dated 25.7.2019 (Annexure P-5), passed by respondent No.2 be stayed.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents pass a speaking order on his statutory revision dated 16.9.2019 (Annexure P-6) within a time frame.

In view of the nature of the order which this Court intends to pass, the Court does not find it necessary to issue any notice to the opposite side, at this stage. Hence, the present petition is being disposed of without issuance of

the notice to the respondents.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the statutory revision filed by the petitioner dated 16.9.2019 (Annexure P-6) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
