This is a first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. praying for
grant of regular bail in FIR no.272 dated 19.11.2021 registered under
Sections 307, 341, 324, 323, 506, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on)
at Police Station Anaj Mandi, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the State has pointed out that in the present
case neither the injured nor Jeet Khan, the person who has named the
present petitioner, have been examined as yet.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, seeks

petition after examination of said injured and Jeet Khan. He has also submitted that direction be given to the State of Punjab and the trial Court to examine the said two witnesses as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage, with liberty to file a fresh petition for regular bail after the injured and Jeet Khan are examined.

The State is directed to produce the injured and Jeet Khan as expeditiously as possible. The trial Court is also requested to examine the injured and Jeet Khan as expeditiously as possible.

Learned counsel for the accused is directed to fully cooperate with the State and the trial Court to get the examination of above said witnesses as expeditiously as possible.
