Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing CRA No.43 of 2020 preferred in complaint No.NI Act/1679/2014

Vide order dated 02.04.2022, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the learned Appellate Court on 04.04.2022 and on his doing so, the learned Appellate Court was directed to release him on bail subject to him furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction and further subject to the payment of Rs.1,00,000/- to the complainant.

On 08.04.2022, an application seeking one more opportunity to surrender before the learned Appellate Court came up for hearing before this Court and the petitioner was granted two weeks's more time to surrender before the learned Appellate Court and to make compliance of the order dated 02.04.2022 passed by this Court.

On 09.05.2022, learned State counsel pointed out that the petitioner had not surrendered before the learned Appellate Court and

accordingly, the matter was adjourned to 19.05.2022.

The situation is the same today as well.

Admittedly, the orders dated 02.04.2022 and 08.04.2022 have not been complied with till date. The petitioner cannot be granted a leverage to enjoy his liberty at the cost of violation of the aforesaid orders.

In view of the above, no further indulgence is called for.

Dismissed.
