Since the main case is listed for today, the present application for preponing the date of hearing in the main case is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Main case

This petition is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.117 dated 28.8.2020 under Sections 22/25/29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Recovery from the petitioner of Narcotic Substance was of commercial quantity. One of the main ground for seeking regular bail was that there was no progress in the trial.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that there are total nine prosecution witnesses, mostly are the police officials and earnest efforts would be made to examine the prosecution witnesses within six months from today.

In view of statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.
