This petition has been filed for extension of parole on the ground that the petitioner is facing psychiatric problem and is taking treatment from the Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh. In support of the same, the OPD card has also been appended.

2. Counsel for the Union Territory of Chandigarh was called upon to get instructions with regard to the factual averments made in the petition on the basis of which the extension in parole is being sought by the petitioner. He has produced the report dated 04.04.2022 of the Senior Medical Officer, Model Jail, Chandigarh, according to which after his conviction by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, vide order dated 12.09.2019, no such disease much less chronic disease was found on the person of the petitioner. He has been given medication for the minor ailments.

3. In the light of the above, we are not inclined to accept the prayer made in this petition for extension of parole.

4. Petitioner is directed to surrender before the jail authorities on 06.04.2022 at 10:00 AM.
5. In case the petitioner surrenders before the jail authorities, the Senior Medical Officer, Model Jail, Chandigarh, shall firstly examine the petitioner and thereafter take appropriate necessary steps for his treatment in case he is found to be suffering from some psychiatric problem.
6. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
