Cr.P.C. for quashing of G.D. No. 035 dated 05.02.2016, under

Sections 452, 325, 323, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station B-Division, District Amritsar City in FIR No. 0015 dated 02.02.2016, under Sections 452, 325, 323 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station B-Divison, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar and and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 07.04.2021, parties were directed to appear before concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 26.07.2021 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar. Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise arrived at between the parties is without any pressure, threat or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. G.D.
