GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.56 dated 08.03.2018 at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC as well as Section 13 of the Punjab Prevention of Human smuggling Act.
2. Complainant – Balwinder Kaur leveled allegations against Pardeep Singh Bajwa (petitioner), Parkash Singh and Gurteer Singh to the effect that they had taken an amount of Rs.7.5 lakhs on the pretext of sending her son Deepak abroad. It is further the case of the prosecution that an amount of Rs.6.5 lakhs had been transferred to the account of the petitioner.

3. During the pendency of the present petition, the matter is stated to have been compromised amongst the parties.
4. Mr. M.K.Bhatnagar, learned counsel representing the complainant, has admitted that the matter indeed has been compromised and has stated that he has no objection in case the instant petition is accepted.
5. While learned State counsel has opposed the petition, but has stated that the petitioner otherwise has joined investigation.
6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and while noticing that the petitioner has joined investigation and the matter has been amicably resolved amongst the parties, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 07.04.2021 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
