This petition is filed for seeking directions to respondent No.2 to conduct fair and proper investigation in case FIR No. 14, dated 20th January, 2022, under Section 279, 337 and 338 IPC registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel has filed reply dated 19th May, 2022.

As per the pleadings of the reply filed, Shivranjeet Singh was found innocent as he was sitting on the co-driver seat of the car. During investigation, no evidence had come on record that Manpreet Singh had intentionally struck his car into the petitioner and his mother and there was no previous dispute between the parties. The accident was result of rash and negligent driving.

In view of the reply filed, since the investigation in the matter is being carried out, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of.

Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance, if any.
