This is a petition seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.29 dated 1.6.2018, under Sections 302 read with Section 34 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Dhilwan, Kapurthala.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Sumiter Kaur. As per the allegations on 1.6.2018, the complainant was present at her house along with her husband Karam Singh (deceased) and daughter-in-law Rajbir. A noise of tractor was heard and they saw Sukhjinder Singh @ Kaka (petitioner) was ploughing the land situated in front of house of complainant. Buta Singh and Jaswinder Singh were standing near him. Rajbir Kaur and her husband stood in front of tractor to stop petitioner from ploughing the land. Co-accused raised lalkara, the petitioner ran over the tractor over Karam Singh and he succumbed to injuries.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 10.6.2018. Co-accused was granted bail. He further submits that the land being ploughed was in possession of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer and on instructions submits that there is an eye witness of incident and she has fully supported the prosecution case.

Mr. Sandeep Arora, Advocate, appears for complainant, though not impleaded as party and opposes the prayer.

At this stage, in order to avoid adverse order, learned counsel for petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Since the main case has been withdrawn, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
