Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been working with the respondent-Education Department through the out sourcing agency engaged by the said department and despite the fact that they have rendered continuous service with the respondent-Department, still they have not been paid complete salary for which they were entitled from July, 2015 to September, 2019 and the present petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondent-Department for releasing the same along with interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that it is the responsibility of the respondent-Department to ensure that the payment of salary for which the petitioners have become entitled for is released to them, even though they might be working on the basis of out sourcing agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners have already filed a representation raising the said grievance before respondent No.2 vide representation dated 26.02.2020 (Annexure P-6) and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Narender Singh Behgal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, keeping in view the advance service of copy of the petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and raises no objection, in case prayer made hereinbefore on behalf of the petitioners for deciding the representation dated 26.02.2020 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner is accepted.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-Department to pass the appropriate speaking order on the representation dated 26.02.2020 (Annexure P-6), filed by the petitioners, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order. In case, the petitioners are found entitled for any benefit the same be also released in their favour within a period of next four weeks of passing of the said order on their representation dated 26.02.2020 (Annexure P-6).
