Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.238 dated 25.06.2021 registered under Sections 504 and 506 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner apprises the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the Police in compliance of previous order dated 04.04.2022 passed by this Court.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagatram has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner.

The only allegations against the petitioner are that he gave threats to the complainant by making him telephone calls and by sending messages to him. So nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner who has already joined the investigation with the Police.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 04.04.2022 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
