The present petition has been filed by the petitioner raising a grievance that his application dated 27.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) submitted for the grant of Stage Carriage permit is not being decided by the respondents, despite the fact that keeping in view the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 21.01.2020, the petitioner had again approached the respondents for considering his case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the non-deciding of his application is causing him prejudice and prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of appropriate direction to the respondents to decide his application dated 27.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance being raised by the petitioner in the present petition has also been raised before the respondents by way of filing a legal notice 25.02.2022

(Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction be issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and raises no objection in deciding the application if not already decided and legal notice (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his application (Annexure P-1) or in legal notice (Annexure P-7), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
