The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to take appropriate legal action against respondent Nos. 7 to 16 as recommended by respondent No.6 with a further prayer for issuance of direction to respondents No.4 and 5 to decide the representation dated 22.04.2019 and 20.02.2020 (Annexures P-4 to P-6) in accordance with law.

After arguing vehemently at length, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedy available to him in accordance with law.
