The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C with section 482 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.29 dated 05.03.2022 registered under Sections 406. 498-A of IPC (Annexure P-1) at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 04.04.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 04.04.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. He also submitted that the litigation expenses of Rs.15,000/- as directed by this Court has been paid to the complainant.

Status report by way of affidavit of Prithvi Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dirba, District Sangrur, on behalf of State of Punjab has been filed and same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amandeep Kaur, has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 04.04.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
