Prayer in the instant petition is for quashing the order dated 04.03.2022 (Annexure P-14) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurgaon in Criminal Appeal No.203 of 2018, whereby while dismissing the application of the petitioner seeking exemption from personal appearance, learned ASJ cancelled the bail of the petitioner. Resultantly, bail bonds of the petitioner were forfeited to the State and non-bailable warrant was issued against him. Further request has been made for quashing of order dated 29.03.2022 (Annexure P-15) whereby fresh non-bailable warrant has been issued against the petitioner for 25.04.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before learned Appellate Court and file application for regular bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amreek Singh Narwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent State.

The ends of justice will be fully met if the petitioner is permitted to surrender before learned trial Court and move application for grant of regular bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before learned Appellate Court on or before 25.04.2022 and on his doing so, he will be released on bail.
