1. Petitioner seeks quashing of a criminal complaint bearing No.COMI/39/2015 of 28.08.2015, titled as **Hardev Singh vs Brish Bhan etc.**
2. The learned Magistrate concerned after making an objective analysis of the preliminary evidence which became adduced before him, hence ordered for the summoning of the accused (petitioner herein). The summoning order becomes embodied in Annexure P-8
3. Both the complaint, and, the summoning order are prayed to be quashed and set aside.
4. Be that as it may, today, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has placed on record an order made by the learned Magistrate concerned wherein occurring echoings, reveal that giving the occurrence of a compromise amongst the concerned, an affirmative order being made on an application for withdrawal of the opposite complaint.

4. Therefore, in so far as the present petitioner is concerned, and, in so far as the complaint against him is concerned, the present petition becomes rendered infructuous, and, is disposed of as such.
