Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.16, dated 10.02.2020, under Sections 323/354-B/498-A/506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women Police Station Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, Haryana.
