Connected petition i.e. CRM-M-25374-2013 came up for hearing before the Coordinate Bench on 11.12.2019 and in the said case, the following order was passed:-

“The application is allowed.

The orders passed by this Court in CRM-M-31722 of 2012 and those passed by the trial Court at different stages and in different petitions, are ordered to be taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

The aforesaid orders, including the charges framed against the petitioner and his co-accused, having been placed on record, Mr. C.M. Munjal, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition, with liberty to the petitioner to take all pleas as are legally available to him at the time of defence of his case.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty naturally always available to an accused.”

2. Today, learned State counsel informs the Court that in fact the trial has finally culminated in the order of acquittal dated 17.01.2022 and thus, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present case.
3. In view of the statement made by State counsel, the present petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
