The petitioner is seeking cancellation of bail granted to respondent Nos. 2 to 5 in terms of the orders dated 07.11.2019 and 04.12.2019 in the case bearing FIR No. 90 dated 21.09.2019 under Sections 376, 344, 120-B, 366-A, 368, 370-A, 109 IPC, Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act and Sections 9, 10, 11 of Prohibition of Child Marriage Act registered at Police Station Division-D, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ajay Kumar, states that respondent Nos. 2 to 5 have been acquitted by the trial Court in terms of the judgment dated 21.09.2022 passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar and the petition has been rendered infructuous.
