The instant writ petition has been filed seeking appointment against the vacant post of Sub Inspector (Male) under ESM-General category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would fairly submit that pursuant to the writ petition having been filed, the name of the petitioner has been considered for appointment and, therefore, he would not press the instant petition but would pray that he be given all consequential benefits as from the date when the similarly situated persons were appointed.

Learned State counsel would submit that the Commission has recommended the candidature of the petitioner, who was on the waiting list, to the Government, which would now be subject to verification and in fact he has already been given appointment and sent for the training course.

In view of the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel, this writ petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, in case the petitioner prefers an appropriate application/representation to respondent No. 2 seeking for consequential benefits, the same would be considered expeditiously and in accordance with law.
