Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for setting aside of order dated 26.02.2018 passed by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar, whereby an interim maintenance to the tune of Rs.15,000/- per month has been granted to respondent No.1 and Rs.5,000/- per month has been granted to minor child and for setting aside order dated 02.05.2018 passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, whereby the revision against order dated 26.02.2018 has been dismissed by ASJ, Amritsar.
