On 07.04.2021, the following order was passed:-

“ Counsel for the petitioner herein would submit that
the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute amicably
with the complainant herein and to show his bona
fide, would bring an amount of ₹ 25,000/- by way of
demand draft in the name of the complainant on the
next date of hearing.

At this stage, on the oral request of counsel for
the petitioner, complainant Kamaljit Kaur wife of
Dinesh Kumar, resident of Village Sherpur Pakka,

Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur is impleaded as respondent No.2 in the instant petition. Registry is directed to carry out the necessary amendment in the memo of parties.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG Punjab, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The parties are directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court on 27.04.2021 where, the petitioner would pay a sum of ₹ 5000/- to the complainant towards travelling expenses.

Put up before this court on 10.05.2021.

In the meantime, arrest of the petitioner herein is stayed limited to the next date of hearing, to enable her to participate in the mediation process.”

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the settlement arrived at before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, an amount of ₹ 25,000/- stands paid to the complainant.

3. Mr. Dhir is not in a position to dispute the said fact.

4. In view of statement made by counsel for the petitioner above, the interim order dated 07.04.2021 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands disposed off.
