At the outset, Mr. Amit Rana, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has stated on instructions from ASI Angrej Singh that in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court on 05.04.2022 the petitioners have already joined investigation and they are fully cooperating with the investigation process and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and he has not objected to the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, the bar contained under Section 37 of the NDPS Act will not apply.

Consequently, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 05.04.2022 is hereby made absolute.
