Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.13 dated 17.2.2020 registered under Section 376 IPC read with Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012 at Police Station Khilchian, District Amritsar.

By virtue of the order dated 8.9.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
