Petitioner is seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 80 dated 10.2.2022, under sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat.

The FIR was registered on the complaint of Tehsildar Sonipat. The allegations are that the petitioner purchased 550 sq. yard land in village Nahri. Vide different sale deeds, he sold the entire land. The mutation in respect of 360 sq. yard land sold by the petitioner could not be got sanctioned, taking advantage of this position he sold the said land second time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised with the subsequent purchaser and the petitioner is in custody since 10.2.2022, investigation is complete and petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel on instructions opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the petitioner had sold the same land twice.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and on the compromise, having conspectus of the fact and that though investigation is complete but conclusion of trial is likely to take time, bail is granted to the petitioner on furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
