The petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-13); along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-13), within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sunil Kumar Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-Union of India and has submitted that

the Union of India is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondent No.3 is directed to take a conscious decision upon legal notice dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-13), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. However, it is clarified that this order shall not be taken as any order qua condonation of any delay in raising the claim as such.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
