The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to register the FIR against respondents No.4 and 5 who has cheated the petitioner and other family members.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 18.04.2022. Pursuant to which reply has been filed.

Learned State counsel refers to para 4 of the same which reads thus:-

“That as a matter of fact, the complainant-petitioner has filed a complaint bearing No. 27-Saha dated 04.05.2021 before the Superintendent of Police, Ambala and the same was received in police station Saha for necessary action. Thereafter, the preliminary inquiry was conducted by the local police to ascertain the real facts and for the purpose of elicit the truth in this case and all the family members of Late Mehar Singh have been asked to

join the inquiry. That thereafter, on 25.05.2021, the petitioner Shamsheer Singh Meena Devi wife of Naresh Kumar, Devi wife Prem Nath, Lakhbir Singh of Mehar Singh and Vijay son Ram came the 10 and joined the enquiry and above named i.e. recorded their respective statements Vijay Kumar son Jala Ram make payment Rs., 1,20,000/- the heirs the deceased Jala Ram and also submitted their Panchayati Compromise dated 25.05.2021 and thereafter, statement above persons attached herewith as Annexure R-1 to R-5 and copy of compromise attached as Annexure R-6. It further relevant to submit here since the matter has been compromised between parties and due reason, no FIR has been registered on the complaint of petitioner for kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court."

She further refers to Annexures R-1 to R-5 which are statements of the petitioners along with the compromise which has been arrived at between the parties.

In view of above, no further order is required to be passed in this case. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail of any other alternate remedy which law permits.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
