The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ to respondent No.1 to step up the pay of petitioner as on 20.04.2015 at par with Hardev Singh, who was junior to him throughout for 25 years till 20.04.2015; along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondent No.1 is directed to consider the representation dated 05.09.2019 (Annexure P-11) moved by the petitioner, within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ashwani Talwar, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.1 and has submitted that the University is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondent No.1 is directed to take a conscious decision upon representation dated 05.09.2019 (Annexure P-11), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioner is found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioner within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
