Prayer in the instant application is for preponement of the main case from 04.02.2022 to an early date.

Since 04.02.2022 has already been passed, the present application has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the instant application is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

CRR-455-2021 (O&M)

It has come to the notice of this Court that an inadvertent mistake has occurred while typing the order dated 09.12.2021 passed by this Court. In para No.3 of the said order, “quashing of FIR” has been mentioned in place of “quashing of judgment and order of sentence dated 15.02.2019 and judgment dated 18.03.2021”.

The said error is ordered to be rectified.

Registry is directed to carry out the necessary corrections as aforesaid.

In pursuance of the order dated 09.12.2021, a report dated 24.12.2021 has been received from learned JMIC, Panchkula stating therein that the compromise arrived at between the parties is without any pressure or coercion from any one and the same is genuine.

Keeping in view the fact that the dispute has been amicably settled between the parties and in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, the instant revision petition is allowed and accordingly, judgment and order of sentence dated 15.02.2019 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula in complaint case No.6193 of 2015 and judgment dated 18.03.2021 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panchkula are set aside.
