Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0044 dated 16.08.2020 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 324, 325, 427, 450, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act and Sections 3 & 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 registered at Police Station Tehsil and District Ferozepur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 31.08.2021 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 31.08.2021 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 31.08.2021 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
