JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on the complaint filed by the respondent No.6, the allegations were enquired into by the police twice and nothing was found against the petitioner and thereafter, the respondent No.6 has again given a complaint to the police. She has therefore sought protection of life and liberty from false implication.

On a specific query put to the learned counsel for the petitioner as to whether any police officer has called the petitioner with regard to the fresh complaint, she has stated that the same has not been done.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as being premature. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner that in case any cause of action arises pertaining to the subsequent enquiry and the petitioner is summoned by the police pertaining to the same enquiry in which the petitioner has been exonerated then the petitioner shall be at liberty to invoke the appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

Petition stands dismissed.
