This is the second petition that has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0013 dated 18.04.2020, registered under Sections 420, 406, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Cyber Crime, S.A.S. Nagar.

The first petition, bearing CRM-M-49699-2021, was dismissed on 07.03.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the new ground for filing the present petition is that now the matter stands compromised between the parties and in terms of order dated 22.03.2022 passed in CRM-M-11982-2022, the parties have already got recorded their statement before the trial Court/Illaqua Magistrate in support of the compromise.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Investigating

Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also acknowledged the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the same, without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid facts, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, concerned.
