KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. by the petitioner seeking regular bail in FIR No. 77 dated 09.02.2022, registered under Sections 506, 370-A(2), 188, 120-B IPC and Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar(Mohali).

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner was not involved in any immoral activity. He further contended that the petitioner is no more required by the police as investigation has already been concluded by the police. He further contended that co-accused Fuzail has already been granted the benefit of interim anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 22.03.2022(Annexure P-3) passed in CRM-M-11875 of 2022.

Present petition is contested by State counsel who submitted that the petitioner used to sit on the reception of Hotel Lucky Plaza, Baltana to keep watch on the police officials, who were on duty in that area to check the illegal activities.

I have considered the submissions made by the counsel for the parties.

Petitioner was arrested in the present case on 09.02.2022 and is presently lodged in judicial custody. On completion of investigation, the police has already presented the challan against the accused persons in the Court concerned, as has been pointed out by State counsel.

In these circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody for any longer period. Co-accused has already been granted the benefit of interim anticipatory bail by this Court.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
