In this petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is for issuance of writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue passport to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that during the pendency of the writ petition, passport bearing No.U9286277 has been issued to petitioner on 03.05.2021, which is valid up to 02.05.2031. She submits that in view of the said subsequent development, the cause of action in the present petition does not survive and the same be disposed of accordingly.

There is no appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above noticed submissions, it is apparent that the petitioner has lost interest in pursuing this case, as the relief sought herein stands granted. Accordingly, no useful purpose would be served by keeping this petition pending.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
