Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0009 dated 08.02.2020, under Sections 498-A, 406 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Behrampur, Districit Gurdaspur.

By virtue of the order dated 18.03.2020, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
