Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner submitted that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the legal notice dated 12.11.2021 (P-12) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with

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direction to respondent No.2-The Additional Director General of Police (Jails), Punjab, Chandigarh, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 12.11.2021 (P-12) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of 04 (four) months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
