The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim bail to the petitioner on medical grounds in FIR No.67 dated 16.3.2021 initially registered under Sections 354-A(1)(i), 450, 506 IPC and Section 10 of POCSO Act and later on added sections 376 (AB), 376(2) (n), 342 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 (sections 354-A, 450 IPC and section 10 of POCSO Act have been deleted) at Police Station, Uklana, District Hisar.

Petitioner is stated to be a cancer patient and vide order dated 18.4.2022 this Court had directed the State to file a status report in the matter.

The State has filed the status report, wherein details of the treatment given to the petitioner are mentioned. As per the report, petitioner is being taken to PGI, Rohtak for treatment as per advise of the doctors.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is at the last stage of cancer and on this ground he may be granted interim bail so that he may remain with his family members for some days. Counsel has assured this Court that family of the petitioner is in a position to provide him proper medical treatment.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer made by counsel for petitioner and has stated that the petitioner has committed a heinous offence.

In the attending facts and circumstances of the case, this Court finds it appropriate to grant the petitioner an interim bail for a period of 15 days i.e. w.e.f. 23.4.2022 to 7.5.2022. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the jail authorities on 8.5.2022. It would be at the risk and responsibility of the family of the petitioner to take care of him.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is allowed in the aforesaid terms.
