The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct investigation in fair and impartial manner in FIR No.44 dated 08.02.2018 registered under Section 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

The respondent-State has filed affidavit dated 04.07.2019 of Gurbakshish Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub Division, Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar, inter alia disclosing that during the course of investigation Gurmeet Singh and Rajwinder Singh were arrested on 19.02.2018 and thereafter released on bail as alleged offences are bailable. Paramjit Singh Kahlon and Harinder Singh, in terms of orders passed by learned ASJ, Mohali, had already joined investigation. The petitioner and his associates have already been declared innocent in cross case. Thus, no challan has been presented against petitioner party and trial against another party is pending before learned JMJC, Dera Bassi.

In view of above facts which are not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition has become infructuous.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of as infructuous.
